
The mystery of the origin of my family name is finally SOLVED!



WIRJANTO is a misspelled version of WIHANTO (RJ for H), but it is pronounced in exactly the same way. WIHANTO is a family name in Finland. It is quite rare for Finns. Wihanto is protected by the 1998 Finnish Association to prevent the out-of-family name. Nowadays, names are no longer protected, but all surnames are protected. The name begins with a handsome double-W. It is also available in a standard V-sign with the shape of Vihanto. The W format is usually the old written form of the same name that has survived. In Finnish and also in Swedish, W was previously commonly used as a sign of the Tawali V. Various spellings are well established for use by different genera or lineages.
