



Dental attrition schema

Right upper and lower molars are shown on the left, followed by premolars, canines and incisors.

Attrition level 1 (not shown) refers to teeth without modification.

Attrition level 2- has faceting, indicated by shading.

At 2+ the first pinpoint of dentin appears.

By level 7 only remnants of the roots remain in the alveoli.
